We would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to the Sherford Consortium, the partnership of homebuilders responsible for the creation of this major new community in the South Hams, comprised of Bovis Homes, Linden Homes and Taylor Wimpey.

We would like to thank you for the support you have shown towards the creation of Sherford. We are proud to lead this prestigious project forward and are committed to ensuring the highest standards as the new community takes shape.

We are also contacting you as a courtesy to let you know that the first phase of construction is due to start at Sherford in early September. The Sherford Consortium will oversee highway improvements at Stanborough Cross, Haye Road, Deep Lane, Ridge Road and Vinery Lane.

This first phase of work will also involve improvements to the local highway network and construction of 600 metres of a new link to enable access to the development from Haye Road. Earthworks, new services, drainage, landscaping, archaeological investigations and ecological works will also begin; all vital elements in the initial construction of the new community.

Significant measures will be taken to reduce the impact on local residents and businesses wherever possible.

The Sherford Consortium will update local residents and businesses via letter over the coming weeks, containing further details on construction works. There will also be a traffic section on the Sherford website, which will be regularly updated.

Working collaboratively with South Hams District Council, Devon County Council and Plymouth City Council, every effort will be made to keep the local community appropriately informed.
